

Jumper Wires vs Solid Core Wires

Jumper wires do not lay flat so when there are multiple connections in a circuit it can sometimes be difficult to see all the connections clearly when troubleshooting.





Solid core wires lay flat and allow you to see the connections in the circuit a bit more easily when there are many connections.
